To all our patients and fellow community members:

When we took our oaths to practice medicine, we promised to protect our patients from harm and prevent disease where we could. We are committed to using the expertise and knowledge gained over our medical careers to help protect you from the wide-ranging and sometimes devastating impacts of COVID-19. We are deeply concerned about the toll of COVID-19 on our community. We encourage everyone to follow basic preventive practices.

Here's what we are asking you to do:

- Wear a mask when you are in public places. Masks should cover your nose and mouth.
- Maintain a physical distance of at least six feet when you are near people who do not live with you.
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and warm water for 20 seconds or with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Stay home when you are sick.

- Get a flu vaccine now.
- Get a COVID-19 vaccine per CDC guidelines when it becomes available in North Carolina.
